

Read this Application & Audition Pack first then email your Completed Application/Audition Form AND Headshot to **president@matestg.org.au**Bring a printed copy of both to your audition.

Applicants must be aged 10 -21 years at time of audition (23/05/22).

All applicants must show evidence of double vaccination for COVID-19 or a medical exemption certificate.

All applicants over 18 years old will be required to hold a Working with Children (Blue Card).

about MATES Youth Theatre

MATES Youth Theatre is a Mentoring Program, aiming to develop well rounded theatrical skills in youth participants, aged 10-21. Under the program, participants will audition, rehearse and perform a production whilst being guided by mentors. In order to gain an understanding of the roles involved in a production, each participant will experience an on-stage acting role and a backstage crew / production role. Rehearsals and performances will be held at Donald Simpson Community Centre. The Confounded Nugget' is the first show being produced under the MATES Youth Theatre Mentoring Program.

the producer

MATES THEATRE GENESIS INC.

Mates Theatre Genesis Inc. is a not for profit community theatre group founded in 1990. Affectionately dubbed "MATES", the group is run by volunteers with a common vision to nurture an inclusive performing arts community. MATES activities include theatrical productions, script readings, workshops, and the Youth Theatre Mentoring Program. MATES are based at the Birkdale School of Arts Hall, with shows and rehearsals held at Donald Simpson Community Centre.

Australian actor and Redland City Councillor, Paul Bishop, is MATES Patron.

about the show

'The Confounded Nugget' is a pantomime in 3 acts. The script was written by Redlands locals Merle Bowden and Trisha Cation. The play is set in a country town.

the mentors

The Mentors are people who have had years of experience in their various Mentor roles. Mentors will work with youth participants during the rehearsal and performance period, and will be giving talks during the rehearsal period about their mentor role and their own experiences.

audition format

All Applicants will be assigned a "cast" (acting) role **and** a "crew" (backstage / production) role. Applicants will experience an "audition" as part of their participation in the program, and are required to nominate a preferred cast and crew position.

Applicants who may be tentative about performing on-stage will be given a minor role with little or no spoken lines. Applicants who are interested in Directing or Stage Management will be contacted before the auditions so they can be involved in the pre-audition production process.

- Applicants are to prepare a one minute monologue suitable for a Pantomime.
- Applicants will also be invited to do "Cold Readings" of the script.

Email the following items before the audition to **president@matestg.org.au** and bring a copy of all documents to the audition:

- Colour headshot (minimum size 10cm X 15 cm). This is non-returnable. Professional headshots are nice but not necessary.
- Completed Application/Audition form listing ALL conflicts with the production dates listed in this document.

cast roles

Prunella Plum: Prunella is the pantomime 'Dame'.

Prunella is a widow and mother of Pearl. She is struggling to run a chicken farm.

Pearl Plum: Pearl is the pantomime 'Good Girl'.

Pearl is a pretty, lively and happy girl, perhaps a bit dumb, almost 18 and aspires to be a ballerina.

Phillip McArsket: Philip is the pantomime 'Big Wig".

Phillip is the mayor of Fullabull and the bank manager. Highly emotional, cries a lot.

Mortimer Montague: Mortimer is the pantomime 'Bad Guy".

Mortimer is swaggering, conceited and loves to twirl his moustache.

Justin Time: Justin is the pantomime "Good Guy'.

Justin is the young man who looks after the chicken farm for Prunella, and who also loves Pearl.

Smudge and Fudge: Smudge and Fudge are the pantomime 'Comic Characters'.

Smudge and Fudge are wombats, who sit at the front of the stage and talk to each other, or directly to the audience.

crew roles

Director:

Responsible for overseeing the artistic components of the production including: rehearsing and preparing the actors; and guiding aesthetic decisions on props, set design, lighting, costumes etc.

Stage Manager:

Responsible for planning, organising and co-ordinating the activities of crew and actors including setting up for rehearsals and shows; cueing actors, light & sound technicians; maintaining props & set.

Costume Designer:

In consultation with the director, responsible for design and sourcing/ making of costumes.

Set Designer & Construction:

In consultation with the director, responsible for the design and construction of the set.

Light & Sound Technician

In collaboration with the director, responsible design of lighting and sound; setting up and operating light and sound equipment; creating light & sound cue sheets.

Marketing

Responsible for marketing and promotion of the show including: preparing and distributing marketing material eg. flyers, press releases; social media campaigns; email campaigns; arranging interviews with media outlets; preparing artwork for programs and arranging printing.

important information

FEES: payable by first rehearsal.

- MATES Youth Theatre Mentor Program Fee: \$40
- MATES Membership Fee: \$20

All participants over 16 years old must be MATES members. If not already a member, participants will be required to complete the MATES Application for Membership Form and pay the membership fee by the first rehearsal. Membership fee expires on 30 September each year. If members join after 30 June, their membership fee will be valid for the following year. Participants under the age of 16 years old will not have to pay a membership and will be classed as "Honorary Members." Honorary membership will be valid for the duration of the Rehearsal and Performance period (and any other days required for bump out of the production etc.) Honorary Membership will expire after this period.

Rehearsal materials and costumes are provided, and all participants are covered by our Voluntary Workers Personal Accident Insurance. All participants will supply their own shoes and personal items such as makeup.

By accepting a place in this production, cast and crew members are committing to attend rehearsals as well as publicity appearances, photo shoots or media calls as required. Casting decisions are made by the Director and Producer and no discussion will be entertained about casting decisions. Application/Audition registrations are taken until our audition schedule is full.

Participants will be expected to be available for rehearsals and performances per the schedule. Please list any conflicts with these dates on your audition form. Detailed rehearsal schedules are released periodically throughout the rehearsal process.

The ages of Youth to participate in this production is 10 ~ 21 years old.

Participants are expected to comply with MATES' Production Policy and Code of Conduct, available for Download from our website: matestg.org.au/members

Participants over the age of 18 will be required to obtain a Working with Children (Blue Card) to be in this production.

COVID Information: All participants must show proof of Double Vaccination against COVID-19.
