CRUCIATE LIGAMENT INJURY IN DOGS

We've all heard of human athletes (whether it be rugby players, netballers or skiers) "doing a knee" and being ruled out of their competitive season. This is commonly due to a ruptured cruciate ligament. A ruptured cruciate ligament is also one of the most common orthopaedic injuries seen in dogs.



WHAT IS THE CRUCIATE LIGAMENT?

The word cruciate means to "cross over".

The cruciate ligaments are two bands of fibrous tissue in the knee joint that join the tibia (shin bone) to the femur (thigh bone), which allows the knee to work as a stable hinged joint. One ligament runs from inside to out, and the other runs outside to in - in dogs they are referredto as the cranial and caudal cruciate ligaments. Injury to the cranial (or front) cruciate ligament is the most common.

HOW DOES THE INJURY OCCUR?

The two causes of cruciate rupture are trauma and degenerative disease. Trauma involves a twisting injury to the joint, most often sustained when a dog suddenly changes direction while running. This puts a great deal of shearing force on the knee joint and results in the ligament tearing. The injury is very painful and results in an unstable leg that cannot bear weight.

Degenerative disease results from progressive weakening of the ligament due to repeated trauma or arthritis. The ligament may be partially ruptured and eventually progress to full rupture.

HOW IS A CRUCIATE INJURY DIAGNOSED?

A history of sudden onset non-weight bearing lameness while running gives a high index of suspicion that a cruciate injury has occurred. Dogs will often demonstrate "toe touching" lameness, where the toe will occasionally touch the ground, but no weight will be put on the leg.

Your vet will examine your pet and check the knee joint for the presence of abnormal motion called anterior draw, which results from the loss of stability usually provided by an intact ligament. Sedation may be required to assess the joint thoroughly, and x-rays may be performed.

TREATMENT OF CRUCIATE INJURY

Your vet will discuss the best course of treatment for your dog, taking into account their age, weight and activity levels. Surgery is very commonly performed as a treatment for cruciate rupture. There are a number of different procedures for surgical repair, and again, your vet will discuss the best course of action for your dog.

NEW EQUIPMENT FOR ROSIES WYNNUM-MANLY






PNEUMOCOCCAL DISEASE — ARE YOU AT RISK?

All you need to know about the 'pneumonia' vaccine.

Pneumococcal Disease is an infection cause by a type of bacteria called 'Streptocuccus pneumoniae'. There are many different strains of Streptoccus pneumoniae bacteria. While it is often associated with lung infection (pneumonia), Streptococcus pneumonia can also cause serious blood infections and infections of the brain lining (Meningitis).





- Routine vaccination of infants and children at 2, 4 and 12 months
- Children under 12 months who have certain medical conditions that put them at higher risk of getting serious pneumococcal disease (additional doses)
- Routine vaccination of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people aged 50 years or over
- Routine vaccination of all people aged 70 years or over
- All people 12 months and over who have certain medical conditions that put them at higher risk of getting serious pneumococcal disease

The recommended number and timing of doses, as well as the type of vaccine depends on a person's age, ABTSI status, state they live in, whether they have had a pneumococcal vaccine before and whether they have conditions that increase their risk of pneumococcal disease.





The vaccines that protect against pneumococcal disease have been around a long time and are considered safe, with few side effects. Common side effects such as pain, redness and fever are usually mild. If you think you might be eligible for a FREE pneumococcal vaccine — please book an appointment with your GP to discuss this. All patients who are concerned about their own risk of pneumococcal disease may purchase the vaccine privately if they are not eligible for a NIP funded vaccine.

COAST GUARD VOLUNTEERS HONOURED WITH CIVIC RECEPTION

Brisbane's Lord Mayor, Adrian Schrinner, will honour Brisbane Coast Guard volunteers with a Civic Reception to celebrate their 50th Anniversary this November.

The Manly-based Flotilla was founded when a group of fishermen reacted to a lack of rescue services in Moreton Bay by starting their own.

On November 13, 1973, their rescue team received a charter from the Australian Volunteer Coast Guard Association, and became Brisbane Coast Guard.

Since then, they've rescued thousands of boats in trouble at sea, assisted Brisbane Water Police in hundreds of search and rescue operations, and saved scores of lives.

Former Queensland Premier Anna Bligh described them as "Ordinary people doing extraordinary work" when she awarded them Disaster Hero badges in 2011.

Former Governor General of Australia Sir Peter Cosgrove, who visited the Manly base in 2016, said, "What you do isn't work for ordinary people. It's work for the most courageous volunteers in our community."

Brisbane's Lord Mayor said, "For 50 years, volunteers at Brisbane Coast Guard have done an outstanding job helping Brisbane residents and visitors who venture out into Moreton Bay, or into rivers and dams around the city, and strike trouble. The City of Brisbane is honoured to recognise their admirable service with a Civic Reception".

Over a hundred past and present volunteers from the Manly Flotilla will attend the Civic Reception in Brisbane City Hall on November 13.

Among them will be Lambert Macchion and Brian Shanks – two of the original group of fishermen who founded Brisbane Coast Guard 50 years ago.

MY MEMORIES: A SUMMER HOLIDAY ADVENTURE

On the first weekend of the school holidays in the 1950s and '60s, our families would set up tents in Rudd Park at Burleigh Heads for the duration of the school holidays. Other families did the same, and many of the same people returned every year, forming an annual temporary community.

The tents were the old marquee-style with no built-in floors or zips; food was stored in ice chests, and cooking was done on methylated spirit stoves. My father (like others) drove back home to work through the week and came down for the weekends.

When I was probably about 10 years old, the boy in the tent next door and I decided to paddle canoes, but the only canoes were at Southport. None of the mothers had cars, so we asked if we could walk to Southport (about 15 km away) to hire canoes. Our mothers gave us money for canoes and lunch, and we set off the next day.

We walked up the beaches of Miami, Surfers Paradise, and Main Beach, crossed the old Southport Bridge and made our way to Labrador. We hired canoes, bought pies for lunch and hitchhiked home. We were picked up by a man who had space in the back of his utility (legal then, but not now) who kindly dropped us off about 100 metres from our tents.

We had a great day, and our mothers were confident we would be safe. Hitchhiking was common in those days. The dangers began later. Most people didn't have cars, and it was considered neighbourly to pick up hitchhikers, especially lifesavers wearing their club clothes. It was a different world back then, and kids could safely do what is unthinkable today.



SLOW COOKED LAMB WITH TZATZIKI RECIPE

CONTRIBUTED BY MUNJA PIZZA

To celebrate Munja Pizza's first birthday, they've generously shared their delectable lamb recipe. Munja fans will recognise this as the topping on the restaurant's popular Gyro pizza.

LAMB

INGREDIENTS

- 1kg Lamb shoulder
- 1 tbs Garlic powder
- 1 tbs Paprika

- 2 tbs White vinegar
- 1½ tbs Oregano
- 5 Sprigs of rosemary
- 2 ths Salt

METHOD

Combine garlic powder, paprika, salt and oregano. Rub the spice mix into the lamb shoulder. Rub the vinegar into the lamb shoulder. Make 5 small incisions in the lamb shoulder and insert the rosemary sprigs in each one. Roll the lamb shoulder and place in the slow cooker. Cook on low setting for 6 to 8 hours.

Remove from slow cooker, place on a board and shred with a fork.

TZATZIKI

INGREDIENTS

- 500gm Greek yoghurt
- 2 Continental cucumbers
- 3 Garlic cloves, crushed
- 1 tsp Extra virgin olive oil
- 1 tsp White vinegar
- ¼ tsp Salt

METHOD

Wash cucumbers and finely grate with skin still on. Using a muslin cloth (or something similar) squeeze excess liquid from cucumber, then set aside. Crush garlic cloves and add to the yoghurt. Add cucumber mix, extra virgin olive oil, white vinegar and salt to the yoghurt. Mix thoroughly.

Serve with cherry tomatoes, red onions and Danish fetta.

NOVEMBER IS A PRIME TIME FOR WHITING AND THE FISHING IS GREAT!

It's November, and the weather does not always play nice this time of year. But when we can get out on the bay, the whiting are waiting for us, and not many fish taste better.

There's no excuse when the weather is good not to go out and bring some nice Moreton Bay whiting fillets home for the family, and by all accounts, most families enjoy the sweet-tasting fillets. Whiting are great cooked tempura-style, grilled in a nice pasta linguini, or any way you like to cook these lovely fish. My favourite has to be a light Japanese tempura batter, served with shoestring chips, all cooked in light olive oil, but for the family to be happy, you must learn to fillet without leaving any bones behind!

Whiting are really easy to catch, and they tend to be in the same areas each year — in fact, I think there are more whiting these days than ever before. This time of year, you'll catch them around the Sand Hills, Blue Hole, on the western side of Moreton Island, Fisherman's Gutter and all the gutters throughout the Rous Channel. Also, check out Chain Banks and all the surrounding sand banks like Amity Banks, the legal side of Maroon Banks, the shallows in Horseshoe Bay and south to Pelican Banks.

In the summer months, I find the whiting are up in the shallow banks throughout the bay in 4 to 6-ft depth, and a sign I always

look for is feeding dugongs. Nine times out of 10, the whiting follow the herds to eat whatever the dugongs dig up, eating the seagrass.

I find them on the bite better when there is a good run in the tide, drifting

with the good old faithful paternoster rig. Anchored up, I do like the running sinker rig, especially in the fast-running currents and the rivers, but in the bay, a paternoster is the way to go.

Baits are simple, and the best by far is live blood worms, but frozen beach worms, strips of squid, peeled prawns, pipis and live yabbies should all catch you a bucket of whiting.

As for rods and reels (especially for the young), I recommend ultralight rods and 1000-size reels. Eight to 12-pound line is all you need, and like most older fishermen, hand line is still preferred to rod and reel.

I use a red long shank 1.0, which makes sense as I mostly use red blood worms or cured red beach worms, but I have to say I was put onto the black magic circle type 1.0 whiting hooks and can't believe how good they are. The only trouble is that my little









fat fingers sometimes find it hard to put the bait on, so I revert to a long red shank every now and then.

So get the rods and reels ready and wait for a nice calm day to go out and bring home a bucket of whiting that I'm pretty sure the whole family will enjoy,

STUDENTS TEACH COMMUNITY TO REDUCE, REUSE, RECYCLE

FROM MRS. HEATHER CASTLE, MURARRIE STATE SCHOOL

How do you get a whole nation recycling better? Part of the answer might lie with our children.

Students in Years 2, 3 and 4 at Murarrie State School undertook a deep investigation into the amount and type of rubbish in the school bins and the community. Teaching adults how to change their habits can be difficult, which is why our students argue targeting the younger members of the house could be the key to change.

"The kids love it; they go home and they teach their parents, and that's really what we want to happen," classroom teacher Miss Jo Young said. "The idea is they teach their family and anyone who'll listen, and we basically try and get them to promote recycling, sustainability."

The students undertook a "War on Waste" action project, which entailed gathering data in a range of ways, including collecting, sorting and weighing the school's rubbish.

The students were then honoured to be invited to present the "War on Waste" action research findings at Di Farmer MP's Eco Forum. Visitors to the stall were amazed by the breadth of the students' research, the depth of the students' knowledge about sustainability, and how passionate the students were about persuading our community to improve how we manage our waste and work towards a more sustainable solution.

Students said they were teaching their parents and friends about what they can and can't put in their recycling bins. This is vitally important!

Murarrie students are active in addressing real-world problems, which makes a difference in them becoming lifelong active community members.


