

LINDUM STATION NOW OPEN

Wonderful news Baysiders! Lindum Station is now open. I was on the platform at 4:45am on the day the first train left the new platform. There I met Luke from Iona College. Luke was the very first passenger to board a train from the station.

I want to thank everyone who has made this Big Build project possible - from the staff at Queensland Rail, construction workers, and former Premier Steven Miles, who was instrumental.

I've worked incredibly hard to get this infrastructure project built for our community and I'm elated with this positive outcome. Happy commuting Baysiders!



\$45 MILLION CUT TO HOMELESSNESS **FUNDING**

Sadly, the Queensland Government has cut \$45 million from homelessness services across Queensland. This means important local organisations, like BABI Youth and Family Service, will get a 20% funding cut. It's also unclear whether Premier Crisafulli's \$500,000 funding promise to Wynnum Community Place (WCP) doors didn't open on 7 January as planned. I recently wrote to the Premier seeking answers. I'm yet to receive a response. I will continue to hold the government to account for Bayside funding cuts to essential services.



GIVE BLOOD LOCALLY THIS MONTH

There's currently an urgent call for blood donations. Lifeblood has issued an urgent call for blood donors recently after a record number of planned blood donations were cancelled, putting pressure on blood supplies. Our blood supplies remain dangerously low.

Our Bayside has been identified as a hotspot for melanomas. Diagnosis rates in Wynnum, Manly and Lota in particular, are well above the national average. Data collected by Cancer Atlas revealed melanoma diagnosis rates in Wynnum were 93% above Australia's average, and Manly West was 81% above average.

To see the shocking data, go to atlas.cancer.org.au. The Australian Cancer Atlas is an online, interactive platform showing measures relating to cancer diagnosis, survival, recognised risk factors, and screening by geographical areas across Australia.

We live in a beautiful community, with swimming in the wading pool, walks and park runs along the Esplanade and sports fields packed on weekends.



WHAT NOT TO FEED YOUR PETS

As we enjoy the increased socialising and festivities over summer, there are lots of opportunities for indulging in delicious treats. It is very important to ensure that your pets are not sharing in foods which may make them ill.

FOODS TO BE AVOIDED

Avocado – this is of main concern in birds where cardiovascular damage can occur. Ingestion of avocadoes may cause vomiting and diarrhoea in household pets.

Chocolate, coffee and caffeine - the compound methylxanthine found in cacao seeds can cause vomiting, diarrhoea, cardiovascular disease, seizures and can be fatal in large amounts.

Grapes and raisins – these fruits can cause kidney failure in cats and dogs.

Macadamia nuts - macadamia nuts can cause weakness, depression, vomiting and tremors. Affected animals may appear to be developing paralysis. Ingestion of the whole nut (including the shell) can cause intestinal obstruction

Milk and dairy - most pets are not able to digest lactose so may develop diarrhoea if ingesting milk, cheese and other dairy products.

Onions, garlic and chives - these vegetables can cause gastrointestinal irritation and red blood cell damage.



Xylitol – the artificial sweetener is often found in chewing gum, lollies, toothpaste and fat reduced forms of products such as peanut butter. Xylitol causes an increase in insulin which leads to low blood sugar and vomiting, lethargy and liver failure may occur.

Yeast dough - uncooked dough can rise and cause gas to accumulate in the stomach leading to bloat. The fermentation process undergone by yeast results in the production of ethanol as a by-product, which may lead to alcohol intoxication.

If your pet has eaten a food from the above list and is showing signs of illness it is important to contact your vet for advice on treatment. It's safest to feed your pet only known safe foods to avoid any issues.

CHOLESTEROL: THE BREAKDOWN

Cholesterol is produced by the body and found in foods. There are many different types of cholesterol. The two most common types of cholesterol are:

- 1. Low-density lipoprotein (LDL) the 'bad' cholesterol
- 2. High-density lipoprotein (HDL) the 'good' cholesterol

"Total Cholesterol" is a measure that includes the good and bad cholesterol. Your 'Total' cholesterol value may be elevated if you have lots of the "good

stuff" – and so the 'Total Cholesterol' number on its own is not useful in understanding your risk for heart disease.

The human body needs SOME cholesterol, but too much of the "bad" cholesterol can put you at risk. When there is too much LDL cholesterol, it "sticks" to the walls of your arteries and acts like a "dam", preventing blood from getting to parts of your important organs such as the heart or brain, putting you at risk of a heart attack or stroke.

While an unhealthy diet is a significant risk factor for high cholesterol, it is not the only risk factor. Other factors that may cause you to have high cholesterol include genetics, age, smoking, BMI > 30 or lack of rigorous exercise. Even if high cholesterol is caused by factors other than diet, it still puts you at higher risk of having a heart attack or stroke, so it is just as important to manage.

High cholesterol, unfortunately, generally doesn't have any symptoms, which is why it's important to get a blood test to check your cholesterol at least annually after the age of 50 and at least once between the ages of 45-50 even if you feel fit and well.





While we recommend aiming for an LDL cholesterol of < 2.5mmol/L and a HDL cholesterol > 1.0mmol/L, ANY reduction in cholesterol has beneficial health outcomes. We know that for every 1 mmol/L reduction in LDL cholesterol, there is a 22% relative risk reduction in cardiovascular disease and stroke over the proceeding five years.

So next time YOU visit the GP - make sure you ask...is MY cholesterol "to target"?

LOCAL GARDENING WITH KAT

A ROARING SUCCESS

This year, I am getting my best crop of dragonfruit ever! They've been in the ground for maybe three years; I got one fruit the first year, two the second and this year I'm lined up for over 10! Although, (in my opinion) they are somewhat ugly climbing cactus plants, with spikes prone to rambling up a tree or through your neighbour's hedge, dragonfruit produce enormous, beautiful blooms and subsequently, refreshing fruit. Due to their inclination to run up trees, they can be a bit of a pest and you might see them untamed in older gardens hanging from trees and rocky cliffs.

Dragonfruit (also known as pitaya) come from Mexico and Central America. As mentioned earlier, they are part of the cactus (Cactaceae) family and different colours are different species in the Selenicereus genus (plus all the cultivars!). Despite being a cactus, they are a tropical plant and do like regular water, especially in hot weather. They still need well drained soil, but will happily accept some compost, and of course, love full sun.

They are a night-blooming cactus and each flower only lasts a night, opening late afternoon and closing up the following morning. As with most night-blooming flowers, they are typically pollinated by moths, but bees will sneak their way in there in the early morning too. Some varieties are self-pollinating, while others require a buddy. Most of the flowers are white (quite common in night bloomers - they're easier to see in the dark by their pollinators!) but there are a few varieties with coloured petals.

I have a common white flesh variety and a pink flesh one. Hands down the pink flesh is tastier; the white one is almost grainy, and it's probably only the spines on the plant that are keeping me from binning it (protection from predators of all kinds, haha!). The fruit is best fully ripe, popped in the fridge till cold and enjoyed with a squeeze of fresh lime - delicious on a hot summer's day. Be warned – the pink ones may have a similar effect to eating too much beetroot at your other end. Gave me quite the surprise once!





QUICK AND EASY SUMMER QUINOA SALAD RECIPE

This is a super easy, ridiculously refreshing salad that's packed with veggies. Serve it as a side dish or add any protein – fried tofu, cooked chicken, beef or fish, tinned beans or tuna – to make a filling main.

INGREDIENTS

- 1/2 cup quinoa, any colour (uncooked, rinsed in cold water)
- · 1 cup of water
- 1 cup of finely chopped kale (use a food processor if you have one)
- 1 cup cherry tomatoes, quartered
- 1 cucumber, diced

- 1 red capsicum, diced
- 1 small red onion, finely diced
- 1/4 cup fresh parsley, finely chopped
- 1/4 cup fresh mint, chopped
- 1 avocado, diced
- 1/2 cup feta cheese, crumbled

DRESSING

- 1/4 cup olive oil
- 3 tbsp lemon juice
- 1 tsp white wine vinegar
- 1 tsp Dijon mustard

- 1 garlic clove, finely minced
- ¼ tsp salt
- 1/4 tsp black pepper



METHOD

- 1. In a medium saucepan, combine quinoa and water and bring to a boil, then reduce the heat to low, cover, and simmer for 8 minutes or until water is absorbed. Fluff with a fork and set it aside to cool.
- 2. Place the tomatoes, kale, cucumber, capsicum, red onion, parsley, and mint in a large bowl.
- 3. In a small bowl or jar with a lid, combine the olive oil, lemon juice, Dijon mustard, vinegar, garlic, salt, and pepper and give it a shake.
- 4. Add the cooked quinoa to the bowl of vegetables and toss to combine. Add the dressing and mix
- 5. Top with avocado, sprinkle with feta cheese and serve immediately.



Happy fishing to you all, and especially the children!






