

## **JOLLY BY DESIGN: HOW BAYSIDE LOCALS BUILD CHRISTMAS CHEER!**

Santa spotting season is upon us! The bayside's favourite festive pastime – counting Santas on rooftops, verandahs, and shopfronts – is about to hit new heights, with more Santas being produced this year than ever before.

Every year, members of the Rotary Club of Wynnum and Manly go into elf-mode to continue a tradition that transforms the bayside suburbs into a festive wonderland. Volunteers come together to craft, paint, and install jolly Santa figures across rooftops, in shop windows, and on verandahs. What began in the 1980s as a small fundraiser has grown into an annual community project, with over 2,000 volunteer hours poured into producing 80 new Santas in 2024 alone.

Every Santa is a tribute to the collaborative spirit that makes Wynnum-Manly special. And with the Wynnum Manly Men's Shed pitching in to help Rotary keep up with the demand for Santas, this creative assembly line is gearing up for its biggest Santa effort yet! Funds raised from the rent of Santas support Rotary's year-round community initiatives.

## PRIVATE WILLIAM (BILL) DODD: THE BROKEN SOLDIER RETURNS

In 1921, the Manly-Lota RSL created a war memorial in Manly's Richard Russell Park. Its centrepiece was an Australian soldier, with head lowered and rifle reversed in the traditional symbol of mourning.

This statue was carved from Carrara marble imported from Italy – the same marble favoured by Michelangelo. The Manly statue was modelled on a real Aussie digger, Private William (Bill) Dodd, who served in the First World War and returned to live in the Wynnum-Manly area. His relatives still live locally.


The statue of Private Dodd stood silently over Manly-Lota RSL memorial services for nearly 70 years — until 1990, when a pair of vandals chained it to their car and pulled it off its plinth. Police arrested the culprits, but the statue was smashed into pieces.

No one knew what happened to the broken statue after that. The plinth stood empty for years, until a concrete replica of Private Dodd was commissioned in 2007 by Manly Lota RSL and installed on the Manly war memorial in its place. It stands there to this day.

Several years ago, Iona College old boy Ted Barber and several other colleagues, all members of Manly-Lota RSL, began planning a war memorial at Iona. Ted joined Michael Muir, Manly-Lota RSL president at the time, in a search for the original vandalised marble statue, rumoured to still exist somewhere.

After a long and complicated hunt, they found it lying forgotten on a pallet in a council yard in Lota. It was shattered, with parts missing, but another lona old boy, Daniel Gill, a stonemason, agreed to repair it. Obtaining marble from the original quarry in Italy, Daniel restored the old statue to its former glory.





## WYNNUM MANLY VOLUNTEERS POWER SANTA POP-UP WORKSHOP

Members of the Rotary Club of Wynnum and Manly have been working hard over the past few months to get their stock of Santas ready for installation at participating businesses in the area, which spans from Tingalpa in the north to Wynnum, Manly, Lota, and Capalaba in the south.

Installation of these icons will commence at the end of November, ensuring they are ready for the festive season.

The production of a Santa requires a disciplined process to achieve the desired outcome - a different steel template is needed for each colour, and two coats must be applied to both sides of the marine ply sheet, which has been previously painted white, in colours including red, yellow, green, and black. An assembly line process provides an efficient way to produce Santas, which are then ready for cutting out by the Men's Shed. Following this, detailed edge sealing and painting are done. In 2024, 80 new Santas were produced, requiring over 2,000 volunteer hours.

The Santas have become iconic in the local area, as new generations look forward to seeing the Santas on walls, verandahs, highrise apartments, and roofs in the bayside suburbs. It all started in the 1980s, when the Apex Club of Wynnum and Manly decided to manufacture Santa figurines as fundraisers during Christmas time.

In 1995, the Rotary Club of Wynnum and Manly purchased the Santas from the Apex Club for the princely sum of \$500 (about 60 Santas). Demand for Santas doubled over time, and the club engaged the Toy Factory (now Mudflat Toys) to cut out new Santa templates. Since then, the club has installed Santas in businesses each year, and last Christmas, 95 Santas were installed. Corflute Santas were introduced in 2023 for commercial premises' windows, allowing for another 18 Santas to appear in shop fronts.

Santas for rent come in three forms: Roof-top Santa, Fence/Wallmounted Santa, and Corflute Window-mounted Santa. All funds raised from the Santa project support the numerous community projects Rotary undertakes throughout the year.



#### Out and about in the community

It has been a very busy month in the Bayside between meetings, events, Parliament and the build up towards the end of the year. My annual Bonners Seniors Expo at The Waterloo Bay Leisure Centre was a great success last month, with 40 stallholders and hundreds of attendees sharing information and opportunities for our local seniors.

Over the past few weeks, I had the pleasure to meet with many of our local community groups including the Wynnum Manly Men's Shed Mental Health Day BBQ, Saint Pete's Pantry, the Bayside Woodturners and Woodcrafters, local schools, and the Bayside Women's Social Club. I was also pleased to introduce Federal Health Minister Mark Butler to BABI Youth & Family Services to discuss the vital support they provide to local young people and families, particularly around mental health and wellbeing.

A reminder that my office is a collection point for women's sanitary products for Share the Dignity and old mobile phones for the DV Safe Phone program. We also have a community pantry available on weekdays from 8:30am to 4:30pm for anyone doing it tough. Donations to the pantry are always appreciated, especially as we approach Christmas and the end of the year, which can be a difficult time for many in our community.

#### **Parliamentary Update**

Since the election The Albanese Government has moved swiftly to ensure our election commitments are being delivered. This includes 20% off student debt, 5% First Home Deposits, \$25 PBS medications and opening a NEW Medicare Urgent Care Clinic locally. In the last month we have also introduced important legislation to help reform our social security system and the Fair Work Act.

- The Social Security Reforms include allowing victims of domestic and family violence to
  apply to have their social security debts waived at the discretion of Services Australia where
  circumstances of domestic and family violence led to the debt being incurred. I'm proud
  that Labor is progressing these reforms alongside policies already delivered including paid
  domestic violence leave and greater housing support for families escaping domestic and family
  violence.
- Baby Priya's Bill amends the Fair Work Act to introduce a new principle that unless employers
  and employees have expressly agreed otherwise, employer-funded paid parental leave must
  not be cancelled because a child is stillborn or dies. This is consistent with government paid
  parental leave and upholds the ability of employers and employees to negotiate and agree
  conditions dealing with stillbirth and infant death. Promoting enterprise bargaining and good
  faith workplace discussions is central to the government's approach to workplace relations.





## **RAT BAITS AND PETS**

Rodenticides are poisons designed to kill mice and rats, but they are just as dangerous for dogs and cats. Dogs and cats may be exposed to rodenticides through direct ingestion



of the products or through ingestion of poisoned rats and mice.

#### Clinical signs of rodenticide intoxication

There are several different rodenticides available on the market. The most commonly used products work by stopping the blood from clotting. Internal bleeding occurs with signs including:

- · Lethargy or weakness
- Pale gums
- Bruising or bleeding from the mouth, nose, anus, or in the faeces
- · Coughing due to bleeding into the chest
- Collapse or sudden death

Other products may interfere with Vitamin D levels, resulting in increased calcium in the blood, which can lead to kidney failure. Meanwhile, others may affect the nervous system, causing muscle tremors, twitching, or seizures.

What should you do if you suspect your pet has ingested rodenticide?

If you see your pet eating or suspect your pet has eaten rodenticide, you should ring your local veterinarian or emergency centre and present your pet for treatment as soon as possible.

If you have the packaging, you should show it to your vet so that they can determine the treatment required

If ingestion is recent, your vet will likely induce vomiting in your pet to remove the material from their digestive system. In cases of suspected bleeding, your vet may run a blood test to check clotting times.

Treatment will vary depending on the type of rodenticide.

#### **Preventing rodenticide ingestion**

- Avoid using rodenticide
- Use live traps or ultrasonic deterrents
- Ask pest control services about safe alternatives
- Supervise pets in new environments, around sheds, farms, and garages

Secondary poisoning (through ingestion of poisoned rodents) is very rare and would require your pet to eat a large number of rats or mice. Removing deceased rodents from the environment as soon as they are found can reduce the risk of secondary exposure.



These include Christmas cake, pudding, canned ham/spam, custard, mince pies, biscuits, tinned fish, packet jellies, chips, lollies, chocolates, nuts and nibblies, and tinned fruit. #### PINE STREET BRIDGE SOLUTIONS REQUIRED

Another two vehicles made impact with the now infamous Pine St Bridge in Wynnum in October. It causes mayhem and lengthy delays on the Cleveland train line every time it's hit. My office has been in touch with Queensland Rail and has also spoken to



the local Brisbane City Councillor about finding appropriate traffic safety solutions. We need to all work together to find solutions that aren't cost prohibitive and that actually work. However, drivers must take greater care, particularly around height restrictions at all rail bridges, including Pine, Berrima and Burke Street bridges.

#### DOMESTIC VIOLENCE PHONE SAFE BOX

Did you know your old mobile phone could help save a life? DV Phone Safe collects, repurposes and gifts mobile phones to victims of domestic violence, providing them with a safe and secure way to call for help. Often, victims are left without access to



communication when escaping dangerous situations, and a working phone can be a vital lifeline. You can now drop off your unused mobile phones at my electorate office at 100 Edith St in Wynnum. Together, we can make a real difference.

#### WYNNUM PRECINCT HEIGHT CHANGES

Thanks to all Baysiders who had their say during the consultation period for the proposed changes to the Wynnum Precinct Plan. The revised plan expands the precinct boundaries and allows for taller buildings, with some sites increasing



from 8 to 15 storeys. As we plan for the future of Wynnum, it's vital that growth balances opportunity while protecting the unique Bayside character that makes our community special

#### WINNAM YAGABA JAGU TAKING SHAPE

I recently joined Deputy Opposition Leader Cameron Dick for a tour of the building works at the new Winnam Yaqaba Jagu Aged Care Facility in Lota. This purpose-built centre will provide much-needed care for our elderly and is a blueprint for the future



of aged services in Queensland. The project is being built on the site of the old Wynnum Hospital, which was closed down by the former Newman LNP government. ## WHY AND WHEN DO I NEED A SKIN CHECK FOR CANCER?

BY DR ROGER DOWN, MBBS, FRCS, FRACS, MD (LOND)

#### There are three major types of skin cancer:

- 1. Basal Cell: These are locally growing cancers and, as a rule, do not spread to other parts of the body. They just grow in size and will eventually ulcerate to produce a nasty sore.
- 2. Squamous Cell: These can spread to other parts of the body in about 10% of cases if not treated.
- 3. Melanoma: This is the potentially lethal variety if not found early and removed appropriately with an 8mm margin by a skilled, experienced surgeon.



Basal Cell cancers and melanomas can occur at any age from 14 years onwards. They are not necessarily sun-induced, but it may be a factor. I have removed 10mm basal cell cancers from a 22-year-old model's nose with a great cosmetic result, and she still models!

Squamous Cell cancers usually occur with increasing age in sun-drenched persons who have been excessively exposed to the sun, including on the scalp. So, if you have a shaved head, wearing a hat outside is essential! They start as persistent scaly areas, which is the first warning sign. Consult an expert surgeon, as these conditions are easily treated without scarring; however, surgery can alter the skin's pigmentation.

#### What would alert me to an early skin cancer?

Get your partner to check you all over at least once a month for:

- The sudden development of a new lesion or spot, especially if it is pigmented/white.
- An existing skin spot/lesion that changes in shape, outline, colour, elevation, or is bleeding.





#### What does all this mean?

Get a regular skin check from a Specialist Dermatologist or RACS-trained Surgeon annually from the age of 12 to 14 years.

Do not trust Dr Google or Apps. Al is far from reliable and cannot treat you! Remember, the Medicare charter allows you to choose who operates on you.

### SMASHED POTATOES WITH SPICED BLACK BEANS AND AVOCADO LIME CREAM RECIPE

Here's an easy yet flavour-packed recipe that turns humble ingredients into a knockout dish – perfect for spring or summer! You can also cater for picky eaters by leaving the potatoes plain, because they still taste delicious.

#### **INGREDIENTS**

- 6 to 8 whole white potatoes (medium size)
- 1 tin of black beans, drained and rinsed
- 1 tsp ground cumin
- · Salt and pepper, to taste
- 1 tbsp olive oil
- 1 cup sour cream
- 1/4 cup parmesan cheese, grated

- 1 ripe avocado
- Juice of 1 lime
- 1 tomato, diced
- 1 small red or yellow capsicum, diced
- Optional: fresh coriander or spring onion for garnish



#### **METHOD**

#### 1. Boil and Smash the Potatoes

- Place whole potatoes in a large pot of salted water.
- Boil until fork-tender (about 20 minutes).
- · Drain and let cool slightly
- Preheat oven to 220°C (fan-forced).
- Place potatoes on a lined baking tray and gently smash each one with a fork, the bottom of a heavy glass, or a potato masher.
- Drizzle with olive oil, scatter the parmesan over them, and season with salt and pepper.
- Bake for 25 to 30 minutes until golden and crispy.

#### 2. Roast the Black Beans

- Spread black beans on a separate lined tray.
- Toss with cumin, olive oil, salt, and pepper.
- Bake in the same oven for 10 to 15 minutes until slightly crisped and fragrant.

#### 3. Make the Avocado Lime Cream

- In a bowl, mash avocado until smooth.
- Stir in lime juice and a pinch of salt and pepper.
- Whip until creamy (use a fork or small blender for extra smoothness).

#### 4. Assemble

 Top each smashed potato with a very generous dollop of sour cream – because sour cream makes everything better!

- Spoon the roasted black beans over the sour cream.
- Sprinkle with diced tomato and capsicum.
- · Finish with a swirl of avocado lime cream.
- Garnish with fresh herbs if you have them.



## GET YOUR POTS IN THE WATER — THE CRABS ARE ON THE CRAWL!

The weather has warmed up nicely, and it's time to get your crab pots in the water. There are plenty of crabs around the bay, and you can tell as there are so many more crab pots you need to dodge on the way to your favourite fishing spots, and some folks just drop them anywhere – even in the channels where all the boats have to travel.

The crabs seem to be all over the bay now, from close in between the foreshore and Green Island, St Helena, and Mud Island, and in the deep and fast-running water on the eastern side of the Hope Banks and Amity Banks. I personally love to eat crabs, but I hate the mess of having pots on the boat, so I'm happy when a mate or two drops off a few.

As the water warms up even more, the crabbing should get better, so fresh boiled crabs and chili crab will be on my menu over the summer months.

The whiting fishing should be very good in the Rous and Chain Banks, with squid strips and bloodworms best for bait. I have been trying to save a few dollars and have been using frozen pipis as bait, which is working a treat and is very economical (and I find the paternoster rig works the best).

The school mackerel will be hit or miss this time of the year as the small ones are growing and having a break close in, but it's worth trying in the shipping channels. I am hoping the spotty mackerel season starts this year, as the water temperature will be warming up nicely – 71 degrees to 74 is the ideal temperature for the spotties to come into the bay. I hope it doesn't get too hot like last year when the spotties bypassed the bay, but all we can do is get the spinning gear and chrome slugs ready and hope for a good season.

The squire and snapper should be very good in November. and the fishing

season **Water Tower Bait and Tackle** 

should be good around Mt Cotton Reach. The Rous Channel and Harry's Artificial Reef are two of the best spots this time of year. Whole whiting is by far the best bait, followed by half crabs if you can afford to use them, and octopus and garfish are also very good options.

Wow! What a whale season in the bay! In October, it was amazing to see so many whales in the bay and so close again, and we might still see a few in November as well.

Till next month, good fishing, and good luck in the Melbourne Cup if you are having a bet; I am sticking with Zardozi if she runs ... haha!

## **FINE PINES!**

Surely most people like pineapples. Unless they're on pizza, in which case it's swords drawn. But let's not go down THAT particular path. Pineapples exude tropical holidays – fresh slices wedged on the side of your cocktail (or mocktail) or tiny triangles adding a bit of zing to a fruit salad. Delicious.

Did you know that the pineapple you are savouring took anywhere from 18 to 24 months to grow? Definitely patience-testing – but that being said, they don't require any interference during that time, so you can set and forget.

Pineapple plants (*Ananas comosus*) are a member of the Bromeliaceae (bromeliad) family. They come from the Brazilian region in South America and their genus name, *Ananas*, means 'excellent fruit' in the Indigenous Tupi language.

The fruit is a compound fruit – the flower head has lots of individual flowers that each form a little fruit that then fuse together to make the pineapple we know, and at the top of the pineapple fruit is the start of another plant! The original plant your fruit grew on will die, so that more or less leaves you with a perpetual pineapple

situation. Unless, of course, you're lucky and your plant produces pups or 'slips' (baby plants) at the base, which can also flower and grow pineapples.

Pineapples are a non-climacteric fruit, which means they don't ripen after you pick them. They may continue to soften, and the chlorophyll (green colour) will fade, so they might get more yellow, but technically, they will not get sweeter. This means that pineapples grown at home are the best, because you can wait until they're golden yellow and perfectly ripe to give you the most excellent fruit!

To grow your own pineapple, take the top leafy section off a store-bought fruit, peel off the bottom few layers of leaves, and sit it in a saucer of water until it develops roots. Then, find a sunny spot to plant it (either in the ground or a pot) and water it a few times until it's established. Wait two years, testing your patience particularly over the last six months from the beginning of your flower (very exciting) until the fruit is perfectly ripe, and then be devastated when you realise there's a rat-sized hole in the other side and you need to start the process all over again. So, maybe plant a couple for backup...

## LOCAL READERS A BOOK REVIEW – *SMALL BOAT* BY VINCENT DELECROIX

#### WHAT THE EXPERTS SAID:

"In November 2021, an inflatable dinghy carrying migrants from France to the United Kingdom capsized in the Channel causing the death of 27 people on board. Despite receiving numerous calls for help, the French authorities wrongly told the migrants they were in British waters and had to call the British authorities for help. By the time rescue vessels arrived on the scene, all but two of the migrants had died.

[This is a true story, detailed in the book's introduction, including conversations recorded among the boat's occupants and marine rescue officers in France and UK.]

"The narrator of Delecroix's fictional account of the events is the woman who took the calls. Accused of failing in her duty, she refuses to be held more responsible than others for this disaster. A shocking, moral tale of our times, *Small Boat* reminds us of the power of fiction to illuminate our darkest crimes." *Source: Reading Guide for Small Boat, published on the Booker Prize website.* 

#### **MY THOUGHTS:**

What a gob smacking, gut-wrenching story – both the real and fictional versions!

The book is in three parts: the first, apparently a police interrogation of the French marine rescue officer (the narrator) who received the refugees' calls for help and failed to act; the second, the harrowing experience of the refugees on the boat as it filled with water and ejected them into the sea; and in the final, we are inside the marine rescue officer's head as she interrogates herself.

She appeared to be inhumanely cold and indifferent, refusing to be apologetic for her callous remarks — "I didn't ask you to leave". "You will not be saved". She said she had no opinions, no thoughts on the refugees. "[In my job] I'm required precisely not to have convictions or a conscience."

Regarding the sinking, she expressed exasperation and indifference. Boat people should have been calm and patient, "instead of continuing their endless pointless pleading ... instead of calling 14 times in two hours to say they were sinking, instead of annoying me by saying it over and over again as if it was me that didn't understand when I did... Your feet are in the water, but it's English water, not French."

Despite being astounded and disgusted by her heartlessness, through attempting to understand how she could have become so, I felt some sympathy for her. "When had the sinking begun? I was just the last

link in the chain." Part of the author's message is that we are all accomplices and bystanders in the suffering of refugees and the situations that make them so. I take the point.

And the narrator's perception of empathy struck a chord: "You can either have it and do nothing, or act without it, but you can't act with empathy". I disagree,



but I recall that as a trainee nurse, some of the more experienced nurses expressed a similar view. It was a self-protection mechanism to prevent themselves becoming too personally affected by others' suffering – one that emerges when someone is burnt out by constantly facing misery they can't avert.

In the end, despite her protests about having no conscience, I think her doubts about this prompted the very deep, circular personal interrogation she underwent to try to understand herself and how she had come to act as she did. The outcome of this is vague, but my interpretation was she found herself wanting.

## ROTARY'S WYNNUM WHEELCHAIR CHALLENGE HIGHLIGHTS OBSTACLES

#### The next few weeks will be a very busy time for the members of the Rotary Club of Wynnum and Manly.

On Thursday, November 27, the club will host its annual Wheelchair Challenge, where local identities will be challenged to negotiate a specified course around the Wynnum business district, completing several tasks, including shopping in a wheelchair. On Sunday, December 7, Rotary will conduct its second annual walk against domestic and family violence as part of the global 16 Days of Activism against this scourge. Additionally, the club will be installing the iconic Santas on awnings, buildings, and in shop-front windows at the end of November.

The Wheelchair Challenge will demonstrate just how difficult it is for those in wheelchairs to navigate the local streets and the obstacles that the rest of us inadvertently put in their way. It is a real eye-opener for participants, and it has also brought about some important

On the second Saturday of each month, volunteer 'fixers' undertake repairs to items that include toys, bikes, small items of furniture, household appliances, battery-powered tools and equipment, clocks, audio systems, games, etc. Other free services include sewing repairs on clothing, sharpening of scissors and garden tools, among others.

Visitors pay for replacement parts and materials, while donations help to offset running costs.

Fixers truly enjoy the satisfaction of restoring items to working order while simultaneously educating visitors on techniques to identify problems and how to make basic repairs.

Visitors observe, sometimes assist with repairs, learn how to triage faults, and gain confidence to tackle repairs themselves. Sometimes, items are brought in as faulty when all that is required is some

guidance on maintenance or how to interpret the instruction manual!

Volunteers manage the flow of visitors, allocate appropriate fixers (dependent on the item to be repaired), and keep the work area clean and safe for everyone. To satisfy the café aspect of the Repair Café, Devonshire Teas are available for purchase.

Many visitors come from around the Redlands, and it would be great to have another Repair Café operating to meet the needs of that growing region. Repair Café Brisbane Bayside is more than willing to assist in setting up another Repair Café.


